AHSS 109. Bilingual Experience in California (3 units)

Course Description: Best practices from a bilingual perspective to be successful on campus and in life. Improve your Spanish, get involved, and explore university agencies and resources. Taught in English and Spanish. [Rec: Intermediate Spanish language abilities or Heritage Speaker of Spanish.

High School Transferable Credit: 10 credits for a college prep Spanish class; Spanish I or Spanish II (counts towards two semesters of high school class credit/one year); Area E

CSU Transferable Credit: 3 Units of GE Lower Division Course Credit; Meets Area E Requirement

CSU & UC Transferable Credit: 3 Units of GE Lower Division Course Credit towards 4-year College Degree Unit Requirements.

6 Week Class Structure: Program will be Synchronous Virtual on Zoom; Class will 'meet' 2 days/week for required zoom sessions; Required zoom sessions will be 1.5 hours and include a break; Additional zoom sessions will be available for students who would like more online weekly engagement and support with class projects.

AHSS 101. The Stories We Tell - Introduction to Storytelling through Film (3 units)

Course Description: Explore how the arts impact and influence understanding. 'Hands-on' experience in storytelling through film to explore physical, socio-cultural, and emotional development in relationship to the broader community; students will be introduced and have 'hands-on' experience with the processes of pre-production, production, and post-production to make individual and collaborative short films.

High School Transferable Credit: 10 credits for a college prep elective class (counts towards two semesters of high school class credit/one year); Area G

CSU Transferable Credit: 3 Units of GE Lower Division Course Credit; Meets Area E Requirement

CSU & UC Transferable Credit: 3 Units of GE Lower Division Course Credit towards 4-year College Degree Unit Requirements.

6 Week Class Structure: Program will be Synchronous Virtual on Zoom; Class will 'meet' 2 days/week for required zoom sessions; Required zoom sessions will be 1.5 hours and include a break; Additional zoom sessions will be available for students who would like more online weekly engagement and support with class projects.

TRiO Shape Your Future Summer Course (Leaderships Experience, Personal Growth & Community Service Credit)

Course Description: Explore future academic and professional goals through 'hands-on' activities! Content will include college and career exploration, learning how to be a 'better' student, developing financial literacy skills and adulting 101 workshops. Most importantly, students will be provided the opportunity to connect with other TRiO students from Del Norte and Humboldt County high schools and have fun thinking about their future!

High School Transferable Credit: Program participation time will count towards high school community service hours; **Process of community service contract may vary for each high school; confirm with your TRiO advisor that your high school will accept program hours for community service.

6 Week Class Structure: Program will be Synchronous Virtual on Zoom; Class will 'meet' 1 days/week for required zoom sessions; Required zoom sessions will be 1.5 hours and include a break; Additional zoom sessions will be available for students who would like more online weekly engagement and support with class projects.
